1.

Al - Falaq is The 113th surah in the Quran

2.

The meaning of Al - Falaq is "Daybreak" or "Fajar"

3.

It has 5 verses

4.

Al - Falaq contains verses of protection for the day and night

5.

It's sunnah to read this surah before going to bed and after waking up, so you can be protected the whole day

6.

This surah was revealed by Allah to Prophet Muhammad SAW, in order to save him, when a Medina Jew named Lubaid bin A'sham witched him



This surah teaches us to seek and ask for protection only from Allah, by reciting this surah as a self protection during the day and night.



Katakanlah, “Aku berlindung kepada Tuhan yang menguasai subuh (fajar).

2. From the evil of what He has created.

Dari kejahatan (makhluk yang) Dia ciptakan.

3. And from the evil of the utterly dark night when it comes.

Dan dari kejahatan malam apabila telah gelap gulita.

5. And from the evil of the envious when he envies.

Dan dari kejahatan orang yang dengki apabila dia dengki.
