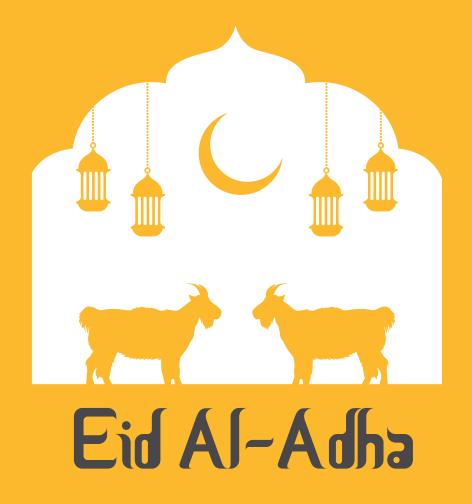


ALIFAH HAS QUESTIONS

6. PASSING A DIFFERENT PATH WHEN LEAVING AND RETURNING FROM THE PLACE OF EID PRAYER

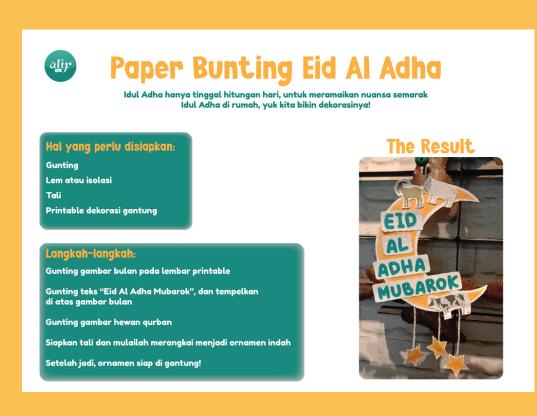
