

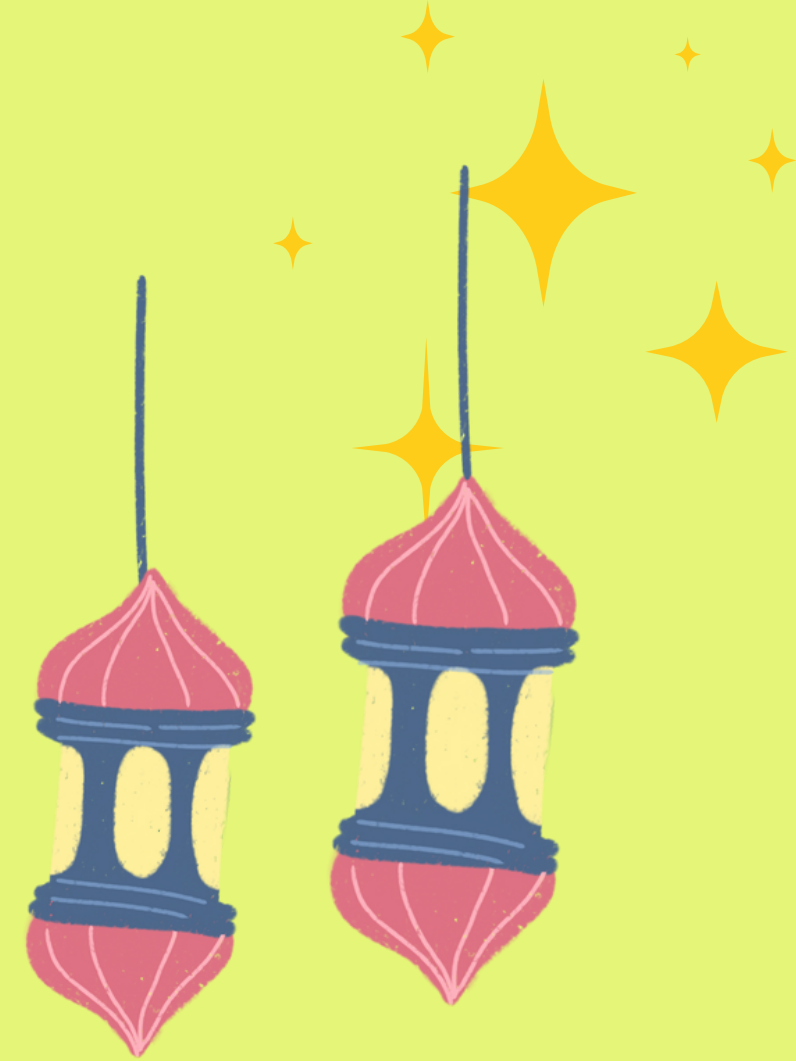

Festival of Sacrifice



The Festival of sacrifice is celebrated on Eid Al Adha by Muslims all over the world. This is the second most important Islamic festival in the Islamic calendar after Eid Al Fitr.



Muslims around the world celebrate this event on 10th Dzulhijjah. You can do the sacrifice on the 10th Dzulhijjah, or the three days after: 11st, 12nd and 13th Dzulhijjah, called by "Tasyrik Days" so muslim celebrate the festival for more than 3 days!

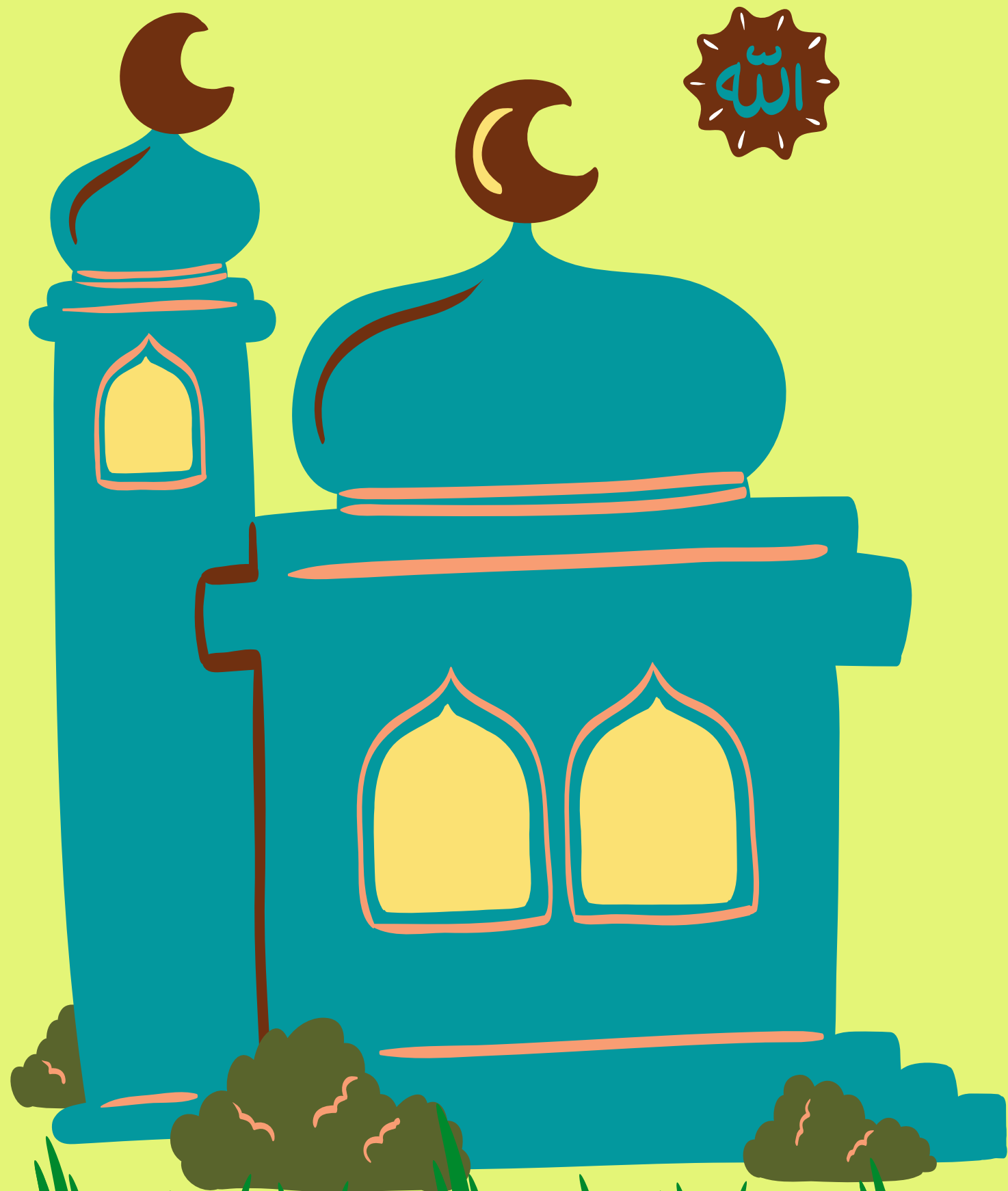


The festival is to celebrate Ibrahim's (Abraham) willingness to sacrifice his son, Ishmael, because Allah told him to do so, in a dream.

At the final moment, God told him to sacrifice a lamb instead, and this act of sacrificing a sheep is copied by Muslims all over the world today on Eid.

Ibrahim was tempted by Satan not to listen to God, and Ibrahim drove Satan away by throwing pebbles at him. This is also still commemorated by Muslims during Hajj.

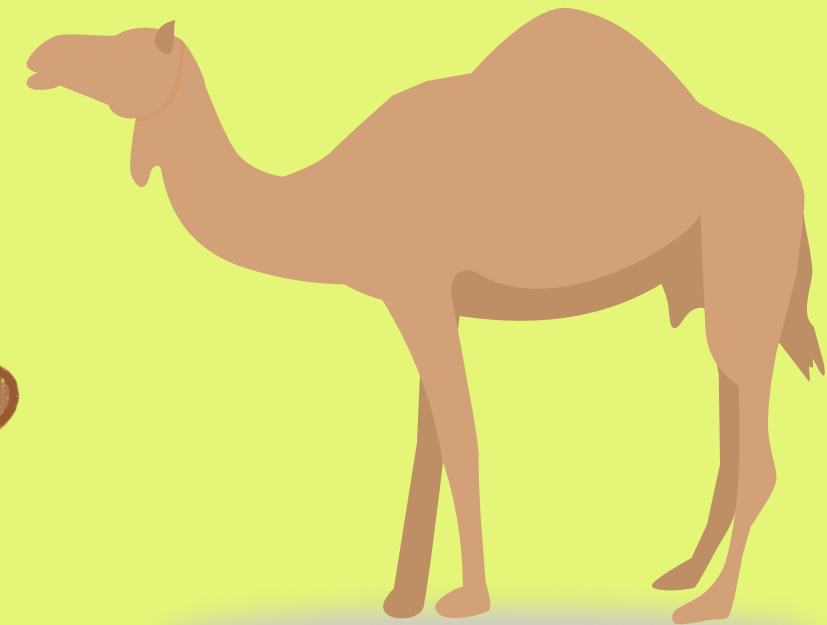
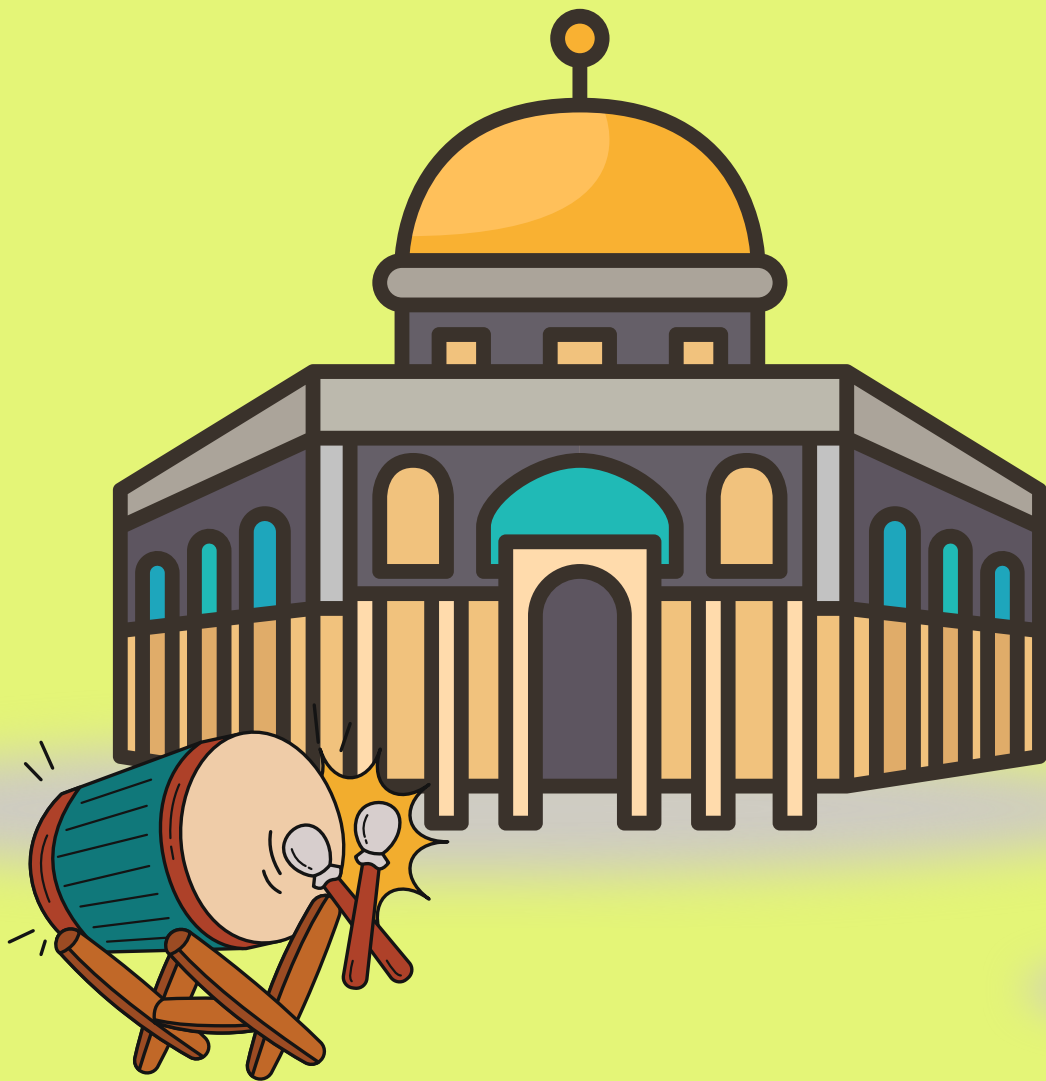


What is animal

The animals that can slaughtered on Eid Al Adha
are

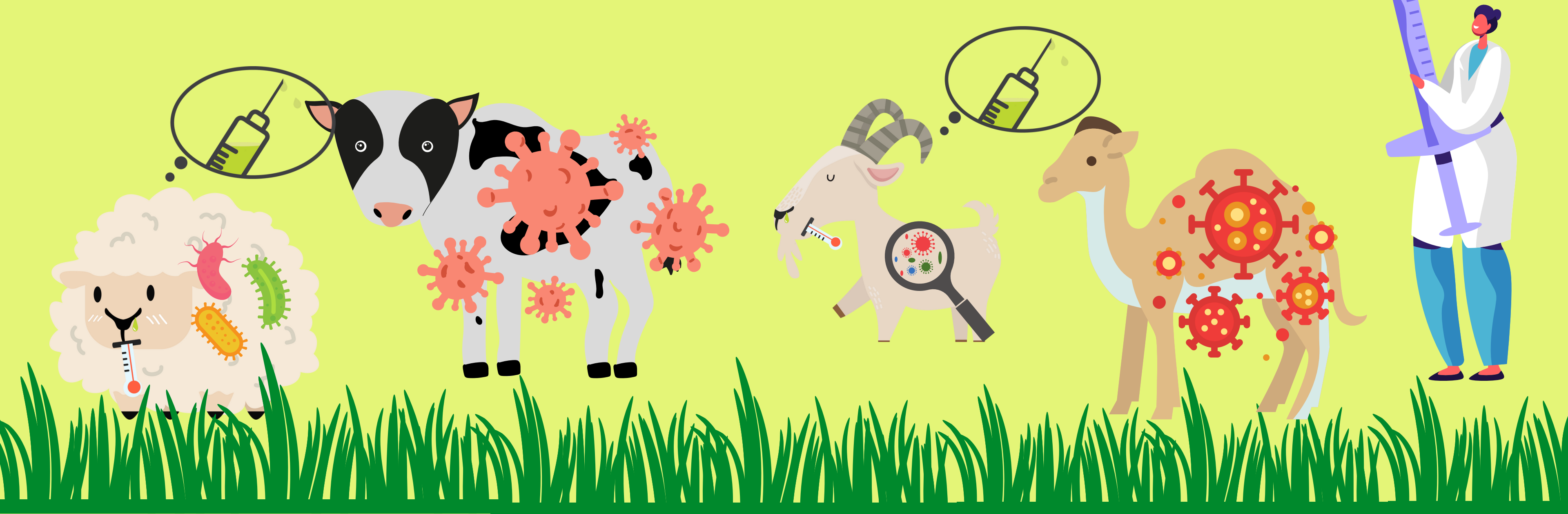
GOAT, SHEEP, COWS, AND CAMEL



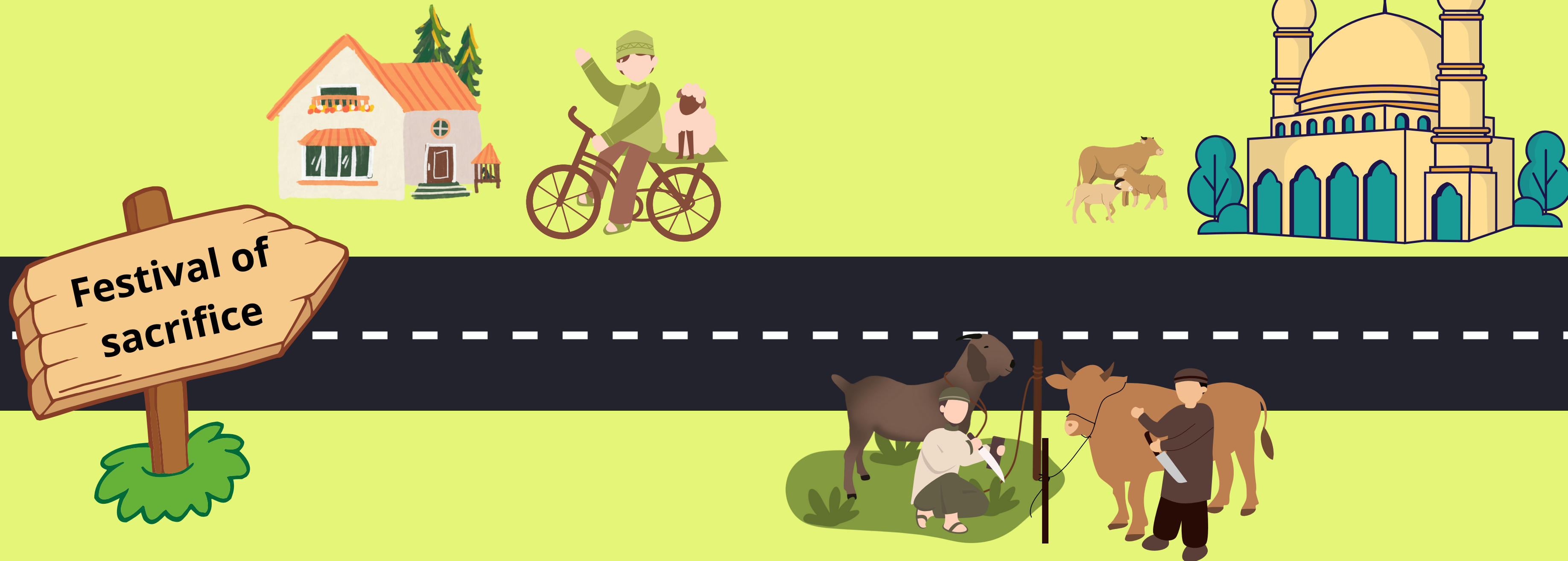


NUMBER	ANIMALS	AGES
1	CAMEL	5 years into the sixth year
2	CCW / BUFFALO	2 years into the third year
3	GOAT	2 years into the third year
4	SHEEP	One to two year

The sacrificial animals must be healthy, with a perfect size (not too small), not disabled or injured (limp, cut off its ear or tail, or blind).



The best place to do the slaughter is near the place of Eid al-Adha prayer, but it is also permissible to slaughter at home, mushalla or a place that has been provided.

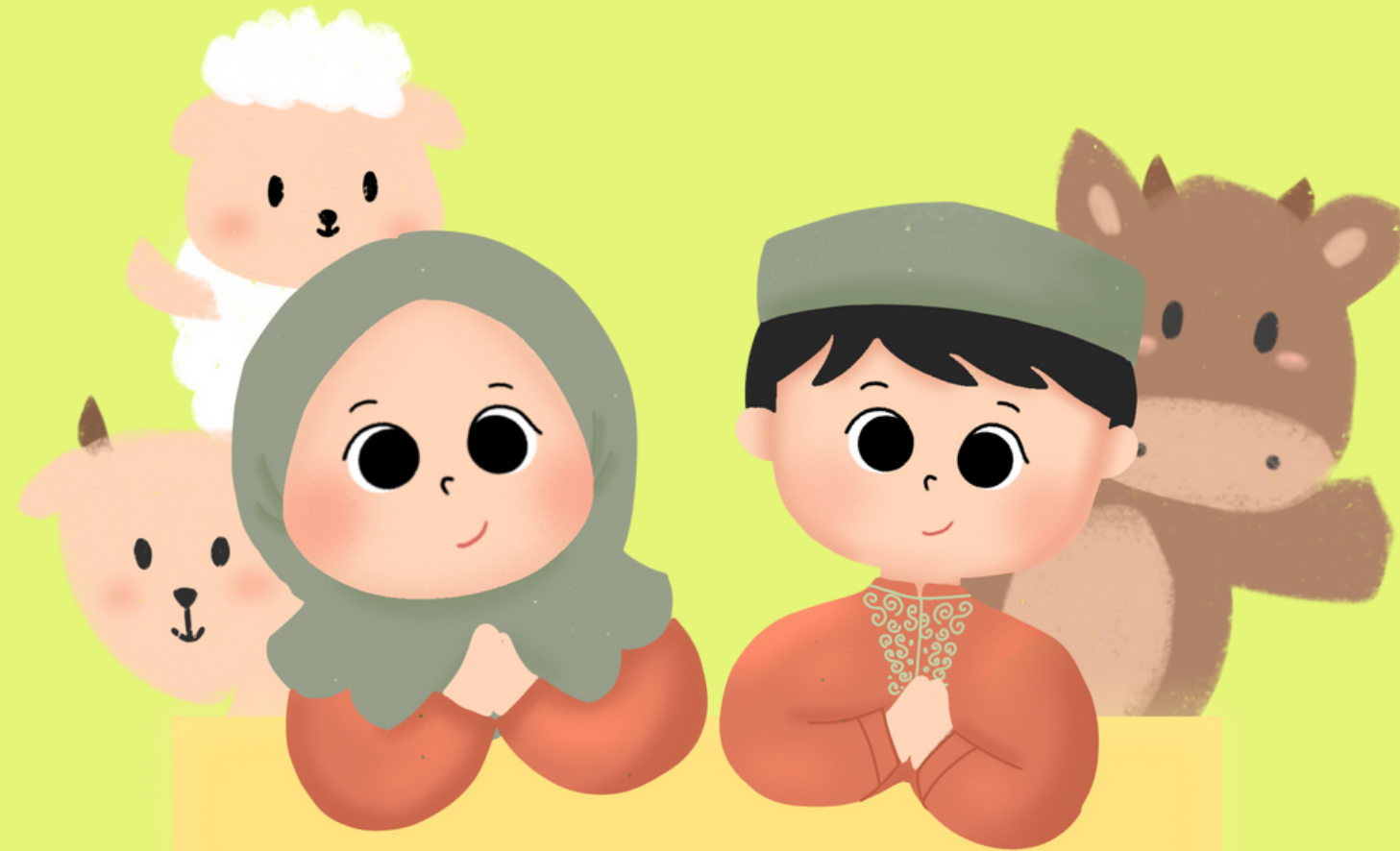


We distribute the sacrificial meat in a raw or uncooked state to the poor, neighbors and to the person who sacrifices or his family.

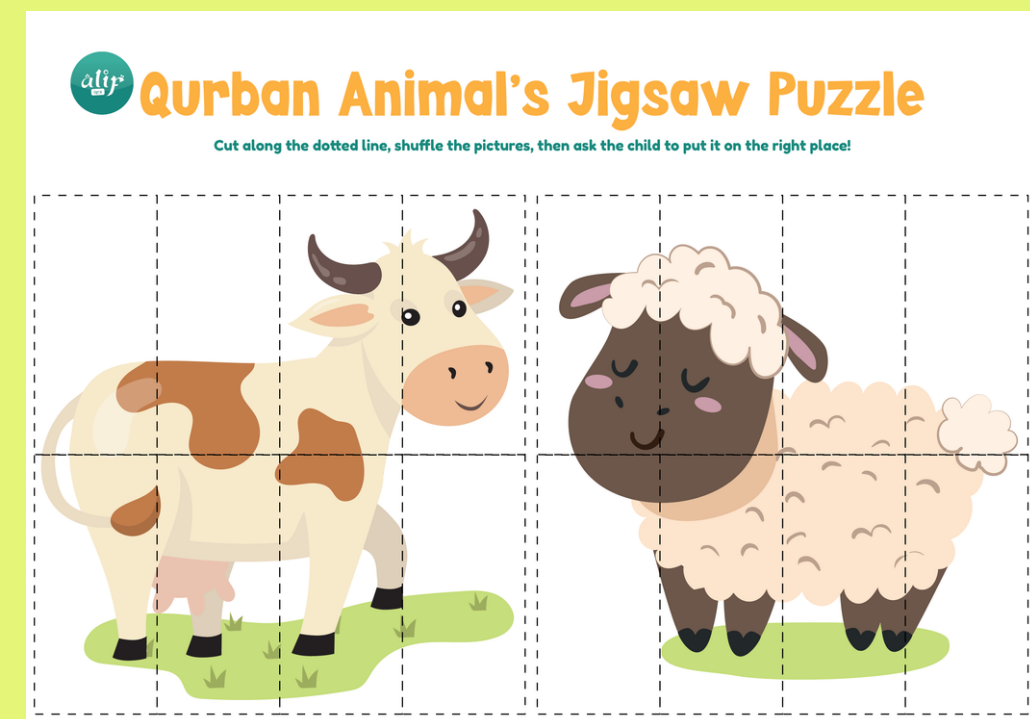
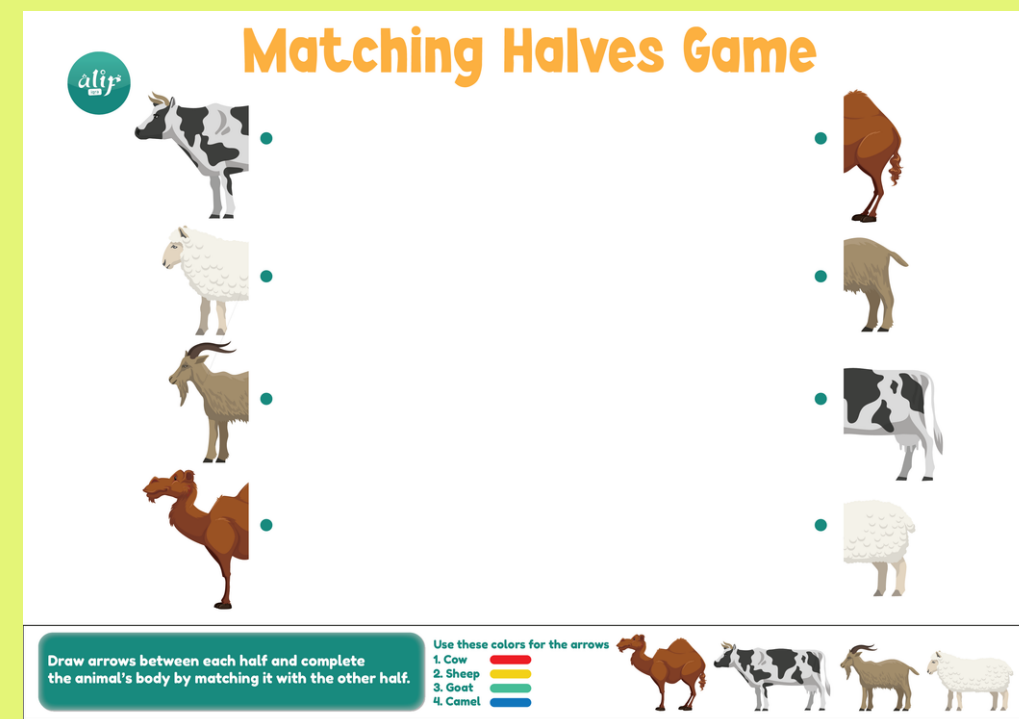
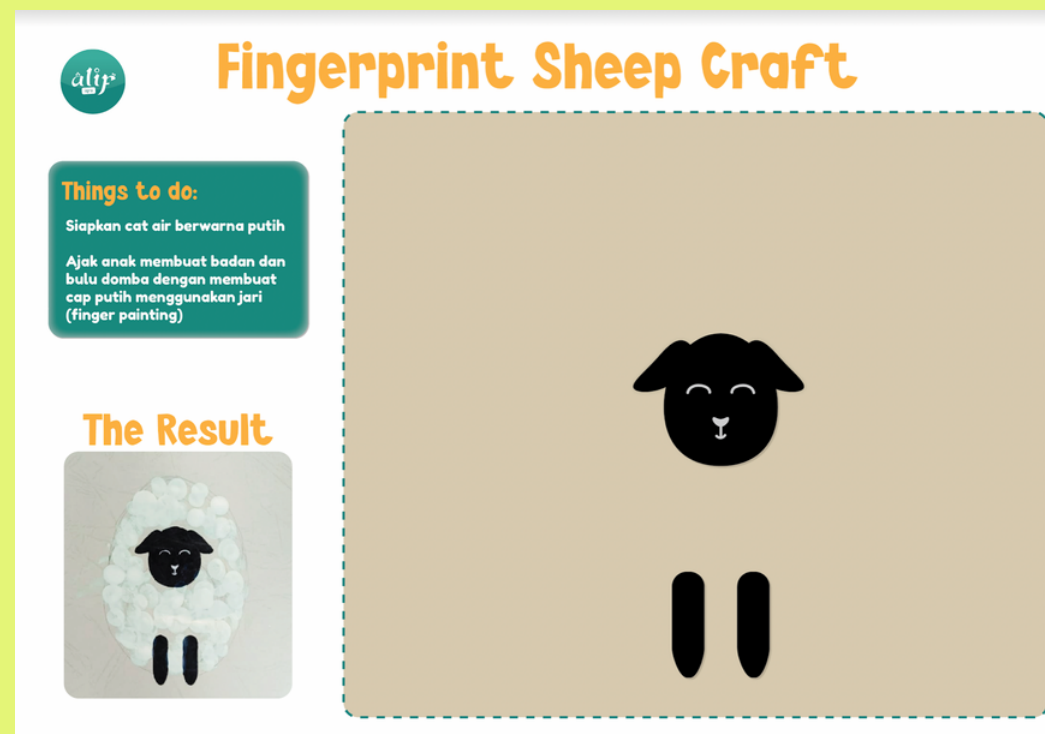


The wisdom of sacrifice:
