Do you realize that we always need for protection in our daily life?

أَعُوذُ بِاللَّهِ مِنَ الشَّيْطَانِ الرَّجِيمِ

We call this sentence (kalimah) by Ta'awudz or Isti'adzah, a kalimah for seeking protection.

So, whenever you feel scared, afraid, or even if you feel that something bad is coming to you, you can read this kalimah.

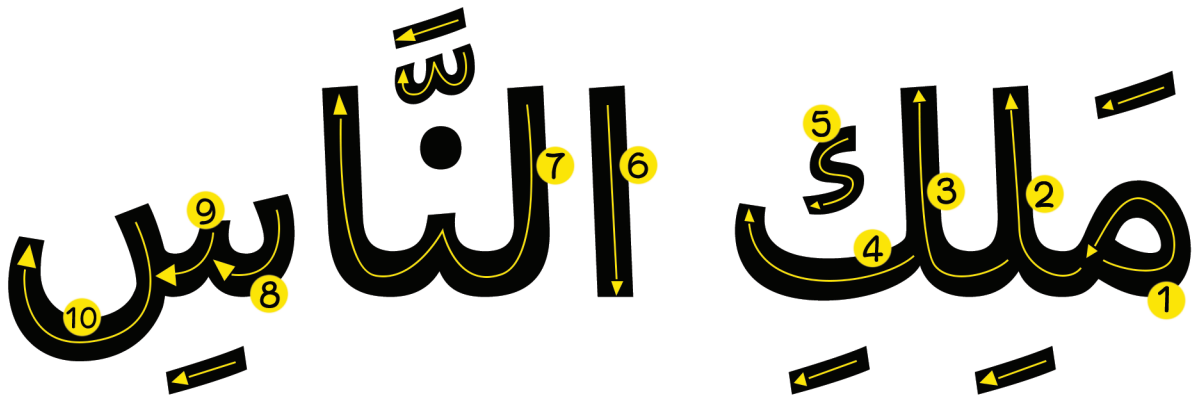
