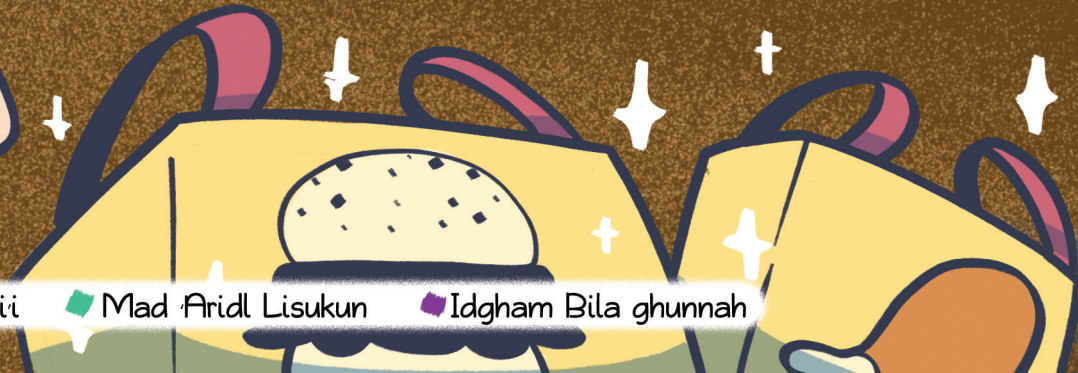

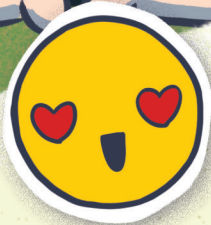

dan enggan (memberi) bantuan.

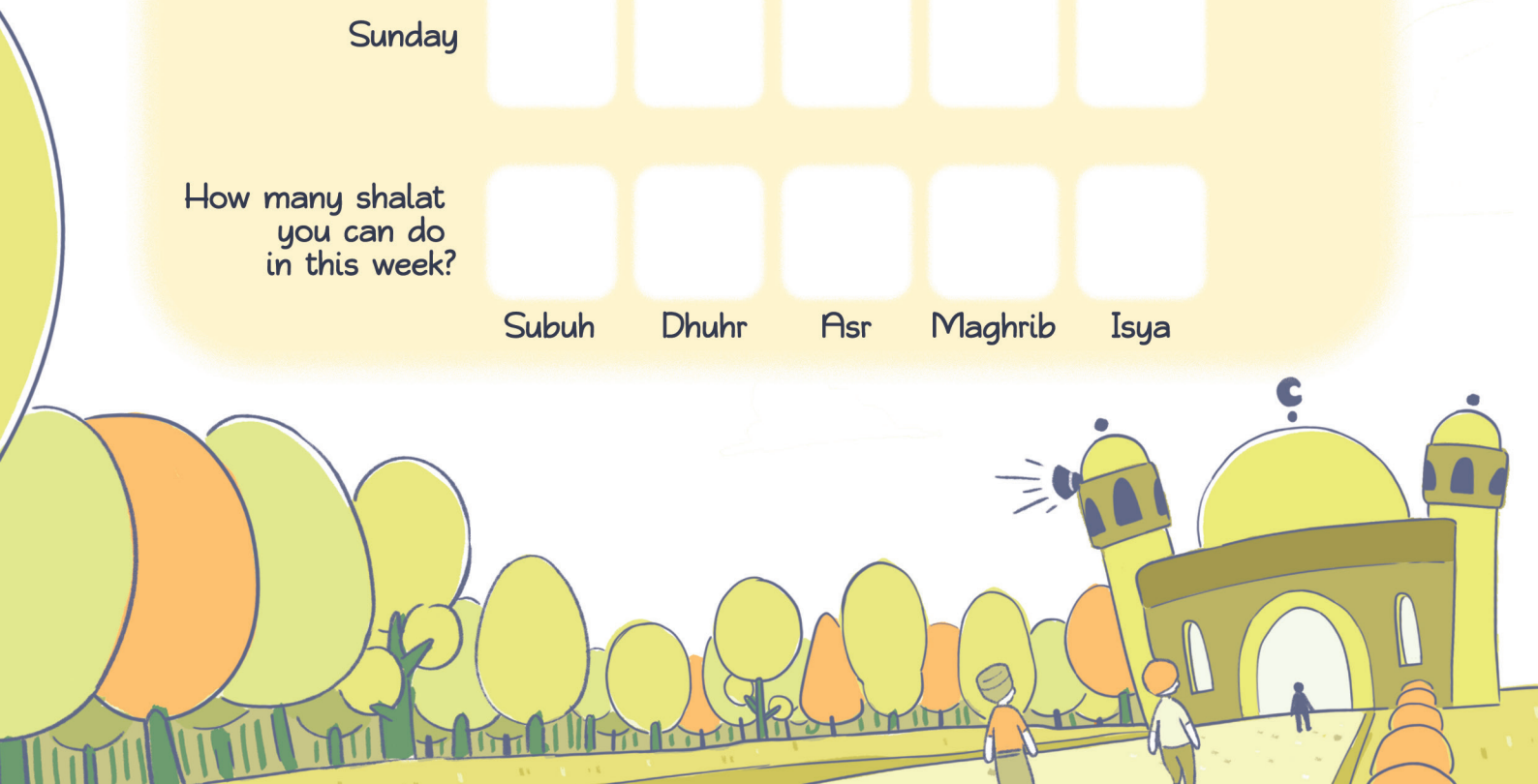
