

Don't Alif and Alifah want to be like Prophet Muhammad?








When coming back from a long journey, the Prophet spurred his camel to go faster when he saw the walls of the city of Madinah, so his camel could walk faster.

"How beautiful you are, O Makkah. You are the one I love the most. If only the people of Makkah hadn't driven me away, I would surely still be living here."




What does that mean, Dady? I don't understand.


I just wanted to say that Prophet Muhammad loved Makkah and Madinah very much.

He loved Makkah because it was his birthplace, and he loved Madinah because it was where he spread his message and made Islam a great religion.






That's why, as followers of Prophet Muhammad, we should also love our country, Indonesia. Just like how the Prophet loved his own lands, Makkah and Madinah.

Being grateful because Allah made us born in Indonesia, a country with the largest Muslim population in the world.


A land that allows us to worship freely without anyone obstructing or disturbing us.

Even our government arranges for our Hajj needs and distributes our Zakat.


Not to mention, the Indonesian government also informs us about the timing of fasting and when it's time for Eid celebrations.
